SOME ILT TICKET PRICE CHANGES FOR 2007

NEW General Admission Prices: Adults \$18 Concession: \$14 Groups of 20+: \$15 per head

Membership: **still \$25** (Anyone involved in any theatre activity must become a member.) Members are entitled to buy a booklet of 4 theatre tickets for \$50 and receive a monthly newsletter. Each member is also entitled to buy <u>one</u> ticket per play at the concession rate of \$14.

Group Nights remain at \$800 for a full night or \$400 a half night to be reviewed at the end of 2007.
