This play is a bitter-sweet and perceptive look at the collapse of a marriage and the decay of an affair. Bob and Chris's marriage has already sunk to the level of constant bickering and recriminations when Bob meets Diana. It is not long before he has transferred his affections (and box of tools) to her house.

Bob is a do-it-yourself en-

thusiast, a compulsive handyman with a longing to be needed. Even after he is divorced from Chris, he constantly returns to his former home until Diana resents having to face competition from his children and his Black and Decker.

It seems that Bob's relationship with Diana is heading down the same path to domestic disaster. This witty and astute comedy takes a new look at the old 'love triangle'
