Add to that an energetic and hard working team of theatre members and you have the wonderful weekend that was our 54th One Act Play Festival.

15 senior plays, and 1 intermediate, made up the program with 14 different theatre companies taking part.

Only one of the plays was not written by an Australian playwright and many of them were also directed by the author.

This is an amazing change from a few years ago when the majority of plays entered in the Festival were from non Australian authors. So much so that we instigated a special prize for the Best Production of an Australian Script.

Our adjudicator, Patrick Mitchell, who lectures in the History of Drama was delighted

to read so many new, topical and relevant plays. The majority of them explored very sensitive issues and didn't shy away from offering strong depictions of challenging situations. Having said that there were also some very funny comedies which gave the required light relief and balanced out the four sessions of excellent drama.

There were new awards this year, instead of Best Actor and Best Actress, we now offer Best Actor and Actress in a Dramatic Role and Best Actor and Actress in a Comedy Role. Our ILT Life Members were generous in their donations to allow the Comedy awards to be purchased.

The Stage Manager's Trophy, instigated last year was once again a valued trophy and is awarded to the group who show the most professional and co-operative behaviour backstage.


