# Vale: Carmel Holahan A tribute from her friend, Di Johnston

Sadly we farewell our friend Carmel Holahan.

I first met Carmel in 1996 through my work at Booval Community Service and Carmel was working at the Ipswich Womens Shelter.

The work there as you can imagine was often very traumatic, but Carmel was always cheerful, helping the women get back on their feet and find their own way in life. She took many of the ladies and children under her wing and became friends with them outside of work.

I left the shelter in 1999 and by that time had "conned" Carmel into joining Ipswich Little Theatre. We both had granddaughters named Brittnee so the 4 of us would take the kids to see a panto down at Bris Arts, but everyone knows ILT pantos are famous!

Carmel joined Daytimers in 1999 – I was directing Priscilla the Performing Pig and convinced Carmel it would be fun and to come along. She loved it – although nervous – and has been in just about every Daytimer's production since.

In 2001, she started coming along to S-Troupe. She had been to the shows but wanted to do more and become a helper. She found a real niche here working with people with disabilities, her caring nature again shining through.

Unfortunately with a few health problems she stopped being a helper at the end of 2003 but still of course supported all our shows.

As a tribute to Carmel, the Daytimers are collecting to purchase a bird bath for the theatre grounds – Carmel would have loved that. So, if Carmel touched your life, feel free to contribute to Kay, Jan or Di.
