One Act Play Festival Success at Dalby Drama Festival

Impromptu, seen as part of A Stage of Life at ILT in March is the Ipswich Little Theatre entry this year into the One Act Play Festival circuit.

The first festival entered was Dalby Theatre Festival held over the weekend of 11, 12 July.

What a successful start to the circuit for the cast and crew: five major awards were given to the cast and crew. Best Play, Best Director (Suzanne Matulich), Best Actress (Majella Gee), Best Supporting Actor (Kyle Breese) and Best Junior Actress (Sophie Stewart).

The play has been entered into 6 more festivals over the next couple of months with a grand finish at Norfolk Island in October.

Of course the play will be a part of the program for the Ipswich One Act Play Festival being held over the weekend of 7, 8, 9 August in our wonderful Incinerator Theatre.

Our wonderful Festival has 21 entries this year and that will ensure a very lively 5 sessions over the weekend. The scripts have been sent to our adjudicator, Sue Gough and
