Alternative route to the Theatre

Access to the Incinerator from Griffith Road via Burley Griffin Drive will be blocked from 16 March to 20 April (and perhaps beyond). This will allow the Ipswich City Council to improve the entry point from Griffiths Road and install kerbing and channeling to try to remedy the ongoing problem of seepage in Burley Griffin Drive.

During the roadworks, our Theatre can only be reached via Goleby Avenue in Queen's Park, round Nerima Gardens and then down to the back of the Incinerator. Ipswich City Council has indicated that there will be signage to remind and direct you. We are hoping that the work will be finished well before our second play of the 2009 season begins!
