An Australasian Commedia dell'Arte Festival will run from 28-30 May in Gympie.

It is the brainchild – of Tony Kishawi, performer director

and former NIDA teacher and will be a celebration of a living theatre tradition which dates back to the 16th century.

Masks were an integral part of the performance and part of the process was the actor finding the spirit of the mask. The three day festival will include workshops, presentations, discussions and evening performances staged in Gympie's Heritage Theatre.

The closing event of the festival will feature a world premiere of Italian artist / director, Antonio Fava's *Pulcinellata Nera* at the Lake Macdonald Amphitheatre.
