Introducing our 2010 Adjudicator Kurt Lerps



It has been four years since Kurt adjudicated the Ipswich Drama Festival and he is looking forward to the challenges that the 2010 Festival will hold.

Kurt has lived in Brisbane since 1971. He received a Master of Letters in Drama from the University of New England and his first love is theatre. He is well-known throughout Southeast Queensland as an actor, director, adjudicator and teacher.

Kurt brings to his responsibilities as an adjudicator a background in English Literature and Drama studies together with extensive theatrical experience in acting, directing and adjudicating

He has acted in and directed numerous plays from the classics to the most modern. Two of his favorite roles are the Stage Manager in 'Our Town' and Lenny Ganz in Neil Simon's 'Rumors'.

He has also conducted Master Classes in Acting and Directing for the The Mousetrap Theatre, Gold Coast Little Theatre, the Ipswich City Council, The Association of Community Theatres and the Wyong Theatre Group.

Kurt has always been a great advocate of the One Act Play Festival Circuit, seeing it as an invaluable means of keeping community theatre alive. Kurt feels that festivals are a wonderful way for people with an interest in theatre to meet, share ideas and develop their craft.
