Light Bites Season &



For several years, the Tourific Troupers have been entertaining visiting touring groups from a repertoire of ten minute plays, all written for Ipswich Little Theatre Society by Ian Pullar.

These have been very popular, but because most of the touring groups come from outside Ipswich, our home audiences have not had the chance to see them.

Accordingly, ILT has decided to stage a season of these plays, Light Bites, as one of this year's major productions, to be produced by Helen and Ian Pullar. It will be staged between 21 August and 4 September.

Altogether, 16 plays will be presented during the season; a selection of eight at each session. The plays

cover a range of subjects from domestic comedies to crimes - but all could be termed 'light' and very entertaining. Because of the

shortness of the plays and the season, we have been able to persuade some of our veteran actors for whom a full length play and season are too daunting, to 'tread the boards' once again.

We are also delighted that our Daytimers, Stroupers and young people will join with senior members to represent our entire theatre family. About thirty players will be participating.

A further different feature

of this season is that it will be held in the Jean Pratt

Building. The groups who have already booked sessions will enjoy brunch, morning or afternoon tea or supper, depending on what suits them.

There will also be public performances on Friday 26 and Saturday 27 August and Saturday 3 September at 8 pm and a matinee performance on Sunday 4 September at 2 pm.

Bookings open at the Visitor Information Centre on Monday 18 July.

39 Steps: audition results

The 39 Steps was successfully cast on 6 June 2011.

The audition process unearthed new talent for the theatre. From a number of enquiries from people both within Ipswich and Brisbane, the directorial team of Shane Mallory and Rebecca Noble, together with the ILT Selection Committee, determined the following cast:
