Annual General Meeting for 2012


Members are reminded that the Annual General Meeting will be held in the Jean Pratt Building

These present the opportunity for people to ACT—which presumably is the main reason for belonging to a theatre company. So here is advance notice of the opportunities—audition dates and parts available.

Amigos (Suzanne Matulich) Monday 10 December 3m 40 to mid-50s. 2f one 40 to mid 50s, one mid 30s.

Five Women Wearing the Same Dress (Doug Moses) Monday 4 February 5f 25 to 40 range. 1m late 20s

One Act Plays: *Big Cats* (Craig Taylor) 1m 60+, 1f 60+ 1f 30+ and *Pier 12* (Phil McCormack) 1m, 1f no particular age. Monday 11 February

A Few Good Men (Shane Mallory) Monday 25 March

13m aged 18 to 60. 1f mid 20s. (Please note that if insufficient men are available to cast, consideration will be given to casting females in some parts).

Good Things (Jane Sheppard) Monday 1 July

2m 2f all approximately 50 year old (40 to 60). One male and one female play multiple roles of 6 different characters each.

Butterflies are Free (Les Chappell) Monday 19 August 2m 20s, 1f 20s, 1f 45-60.

Note that the ages given are those of the characters; the players could be a different age — young people have often played elderly characters etc.
