

Back in Business

Having been in lock down since March with apparently no possibility of mounting productions by any of our groups in either of our buildings, we were at the point of despair. This situation has of course, been wreaking havoc on our finances and on the well-being of members of our society and of our broader community. Our Executive and Selection Committee had given a great deal of thought to what could possibly be done to redress this situation and had come up with a number of innovative ideas. We were determined that we would be in a position to hit the ground running if, and when, the situation improved.

And then on Friday 13 November, the Government announced a major relaxation of the COVID restrictions. As a result, the Executive and Selection Committee held an emergency meeting and completely revised the programme for 2021 which is revealed on Page 2.

There are however, a few conditions which have been imposed on us by government regulation. Firstly we can only accept bookings via our website for **social groups** which will be seated at tables of four, or tables of five to eight, socially separated from adjacent tables. **Each group booking must be made by one person who will need to supply the names and addresses, email and mobile numbers of all members of the group.**

Secondly, we are **not permitted to serve food**, so it would be a good idea if each group provided food to be shared on their table, but not with any other table. Drinks will still be available from the bar.

The charge for the evening will be \$15 per head. The gate check-in will be opened at 6:30 for commencement of the quiz at 7 pm. It would be appreciated if each group entered the grounds together as a group,
