Archives

During the Christmas 'break' when it was too hot to work outside, Ian Pullar compiled two albums to add to our valuable collection of records. The first of these was a collection of photographs and information about the other twelve incinerators designed by the Reverberatory Incinerator and Engineering Company, RIECo, of which Walter Burley Griffin was a partner.

The second album is a pictorial history of the development of our Incinerator Complex from 1936 (when it was built) to 2019 (when we celebrated 50 years of its use as a theatre). The nearly 200 photographs came from a variety of sources of which by far the major one was the pictures taken by and stored by Col and Jan Paterson to whom we owe a debt of gratitude.
