

Our prize-winning Courtyard roof was installed in 2016 (it's hard to believe that that was seven years ago) and had started to show signs of rust. It was therefore desirable that protective action be taken. In order to reduce the cost of a professional paint job, Chris Greenhill

and Ian Pullar (pictured) spent most of the midyear school holidays on scaffolding and ladders, scrubbing down the steel work, applying a primer and then a coat of epoxy paint. The result is very pleasing. They plan to return during the next school break to apply a second coat of paint (provided their bruised "butts" have recovered by then!)
