

As an actor, Allana has toured with the Queensland Arts Council, performed in a number of Shakespearean productions with Trocadero Productions and since moving to Toowoomba, has performed in a number of Em-

pire Theatre productions. She was also a guest in episode 21 of "Am I old yet?" podcast.

Previously Allana has also adjudicated at the Roma, Cairns, Sunshine Coast, Ipswich and Silkstone Junior Eisteddfods.
