Light Bites

Longing to act? Short of time? 'Light Bites' might be the answer. The fourth major season of 2011 is experimental and different. It comprises a number of performances of ten minutes plays – brunches, lunches, and suppers – from Sunday 21 August to Sunday 4 September. As these plays are not only short but, for the most part, two handers, rehearsals are easy to arrange, lines are minimal but the enjoyment is tremendous.

The idea is to prepare at least a dozen plays even though only

seven and eight will be required for any one performance session.

This flexibility may suit an actor who cannot perform the conventional four nights in a row. Some of these plays, it is hoped, will then be available for Tourific Trouper performances so if you are interested in joining this day time group here is your opportunity.

At this stage to facilitate the choice of plays from a selection of 20 or so, all of which have been written by lan Pullar, any interested participators are asked to contact lan or Helen.

Ipswich Musical Theatre Company suffered great losses in the floods as their storage space at the McMahons Centre was devastated by the incoming water bringing with it mud, debris and mess.

Our thoughts go out to our 'sister' theatre group in Ipswich. Queensland Theatre Company was also inundated to about 1.2 metres at the peak of the recent flood. Their performance studio, seating bank, artist and bar facilities were extensively damaged, and extensive damage was also done to costumes, props and furniture. The damage bill is yet to be fully understood.

But as they say, the show must go on. It's going to be a significant challenge to get the first show for 2011 on stage, so they ask for your patience and understanding as they catch up.
