

Memorial for Beryl Johnston



On Sunday 12 September, the Ipswich Historical Society held a memorial function for Beryl at Cooneana Heritage Centre. Helen and Ian Pullar were among the invited guests and Ian delivered an address covering Beryl's considerable contribution to Ipswich Little Theatre. A further address by Arthur Frame included references to his association with her at ILT as well as her major contribution to the history and heritage of Ipswich. He noted that Beryl was the first inductee to the Ipswich Heritage Hall of Fame.

The Historical Society has set up a display room in their headquarters to be known as the Beryl Johnston Room and is happy to receive donations to assist with its establishment. ILT is making a donation. If any members would also like to be included in this, they can do

so through Secretary Helen.

A further tribute will be made after this year's AGM (see Page 3) when a pavement will be laid in the memorial garden in honour of Beryl
